



## LAKESIDE VOLLEYBALL CLUB 2018 GREAT NOR'EASTER I MARCH 10<sup>TH</sup> AND 11<sup>TH</sup>

### COMPETITION FORMAT

Both rounds of pool play and playoffs are match play with two sets to 25 points starting at zero, and a deciding set to 15 points if needed, no cap. **All teams participate in playoffs.** Ties for seeding into round 2 and playoff divisions will be settled as follows:

- Two-way tie: head to head results (even if elimination from gold playoffs is possibility).
- Three-way tie: match %, followed by set %, followed by total pool point differential, coin toss (even if elimination from gold playoffs is possibility).

**ALL MATCHES ARE ASAP** after each team's first match of the day. Play begins promptly at 8:00 am each day. Times listed on the schedule for subsequent matches are estimates. Late teams may be subjected to point penalties. (See work team section). Liberos can serve for one position.

### Great Nor'Easter I

- 14-and-under: 28 teams divided into seven 4-team pools playing two rounds of pool play on Saturday and Sunday morning before playoffs consisting of Gold (8 teams), Silver (8 teams) Bronze (6 teams) and Diamond (6 teams) brackets. Matches will be played at Makeel Christian Academy (courts 1 & 2), Schenectady High School (courts 3 - 5), and Schenectady YMCA (courts 6 & 7).
- 15-and-under: 24 teams divided into six 4-team pools, playing two rounds of pool play on Saturday and Sunday morning before playoffs consisting of Gold (6 teams), Silver (6 teams), Bronze (6 teams) and Diamond (6 teams) playoffs. Matches will be played at the Saratoga Recreation Center (courts 1 – 4) and Gavin Park (courts 5 - 6).
- 18-and-under: 32 teams divided into eight 4-team pools (2 pools in round 1 will be power pools) playing two rounds of pool play on Saturday and Sunday morning before playoffs consisting of Gold (10 teams), Silver (10 teams), Bronze (6 teams) and Diamond (6 teams) brackets. Matches will be played at Union College (courts 1 – 8)

### COACHES:

Coaches must be at a minimum IMPACT certified. One coach must remain court-side when their team is working. No team will be allowed to play without first submitting **2 copies of an updated webpoint roster** and providing proof of USAV medical waiver forms for each player. Failure to comply can result in expulsion of your team from future tournaments. In order to keep our site coordinators from being swarmed with parents, it would be helpful if coaches **ONLY** ask any questions or voice concerns. **PLEASE LET YOUR FAMILIES KNOW.**

### **WORK TEAMS:**

Each team will provide a certified second official, certified scorekeeper, libero tracker, score flipper, and two lines people for each work assignment. Pool play work schedules are listed. Please check the work teams carefully. Teams that are late to officiate will be penalized in their next match, one point per minute that they cannot provide a full work crew. If the team is not available to work within 15 minutes, they will forfeit their next match. **Please be flexible in your work team assignments, and check with the site coordinator if unsure.**

### **PLAYOFF WORK TEAMS:**

Please check the playoff charts carefully for work assignments. You may be assigned to work a match on your court previous to playing. After losing in the playoffs, you must remain to work the next assigned match on your court. For final matches on Sunday, if two teams are available to work, consideration will be made for the team travelling the furthest distance when that option occurs. We reserve the right to change work team assignments. **Coaches should not leave without checking with the site coordinator for any changes.**

### **WARM-UP TIMES:**

For each team's first match of the day: 2 minutes shared, then 4 minutes each team.  
For remaining matches: each team will receive 3 minutes.

### **AWARDS:**

Medals will be awarded to the Champions, 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finish teams in the Gold Division. Additionally, 1<sup>st</sup> place finish teams for the Silver, Bronze and Diamond divisions will receive medals.
